Background

On June 24, 2010, the Board of Education adopted a resolution to study its current trustee election system in light of the California Voting Rights Act ("Act") in order to determine if any changes are necessary to ensure compliance with the Act. On January 13, 2011, the board authorized the administration to select a demographer and engage legal counsel in order to analyze the election system as it pertains to the district. Assessment at the four increasingly detailed levels of review were completed and a recommendation was made to the board accordingly on October 6, 2011. On October 27, 2011, the board adopted a resolution to initiate transition to a by-trustee area election system, including a statement of intent to seek a waiver of the election requirements from the State Board of Education. Draft trustee area maps developed by National Demographics Corporation, the district's demographer, will be presented for review and discussion by the Board of Education.
